Not moving/can't be woken up.



Snoring/gurgling/coughing sounds.



Slow or undetectable.



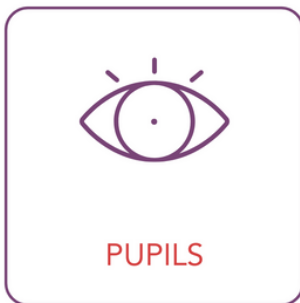
Disoriented/confused.



Discoloration of lips and/or nails.



Cold and/or clammy skin.





Tiny/constricted pupils.

What to do:

CALL 911

Then



GIVE BREATHS **NALOXONE**

1 breath every 5 seconds Administer Naloxone if you have it.
